General Eligibility Factors for Wellness Court:

- ✓ The Defendant is not currently charged with any sex offense or arson.
- ✓ The Defendant is not currently charged with an offense involving a child victim.
- ✓ The Defendant does not have a history of serious or repetitive violence.
- ✓ The Defendant is not NGRI or Incompetent to Stand Trial.
- ✓ The Defendant does not have a history of sex offenses or child victim offenses.
- ✓ The Defendant does not have a history of offenses which were not driven by mental illness.
- ✓ The Defendant is a Lorain County Resident.
- ✓ The Defendant does not pose a significant risk of harm to Wellness Court staff.
- ✓ The current offense is eligible for a CCS, or the Defendant has been sentenced to a CCS, including Defendants who have been judicially released.

TRACK 1: INTERVENTION ELIGIBLE:

_____ All must apply to be eligible for "intervention track."

- ✓ The Defendant meets all of the general eligibility requirements (above).
- ✓ The Defendant meets the mandates of R.C. 2951.041 (Intervention Statute).

TRACK 2: POST-CONVICTION:

_____ The Defendant meets the general eligibility requirements (above) and has been or will be sentenced to a CCS, minimum of (2) years with either ISP. The assigned judge will maintain the case through sentencing and if the assigned judge decides to utilize Wellness Court for the accepted participant, the case will then be transferred to the docket of the Wellness Court post sentencing.

_____ The Defendant applies for and is accepted into the Wellness Court during the pendency of a supervision violation, the assigned judge maintains the case through the violation hearing, and if the assigned judge decides to utilize Wellness Court for the accepted participant, the case will be transferred to the Wellness Court post violation hearing.

_____ **Intervention Violation**—the Defendant meets the general eligibility requirements (above). If the assigned judge decides to utilize Wellness Court for the accepted participant post intervention violation and conviction, the case will be transferred to the Wellness Court post hearing.

_____ **Judicial Release**—the Defendant meets the general eligibility requirements (above). Wellness Court can be utilized as a part of judicial release supervision either at the beginning of the release or pending violation of supervision. If the assigned judge decides to utilize Wellness Court for the accepted participant on judicial release, the case will be transferred to the Wellness Court docket post hearing.
