**JOURNAL ENTRY**

Effective June 2, 2021 at 12:01 a.m., the Governor and the Director of the Ohio Department of Health are lifting all emergency and public health orders regarding the COVID-19 Pandemic, except those relating to congregate living and healthcare settings. Accordingly, the Orders filed on May 13, 2020 and December 9, 2020 are hereby rescinded effective June 2, 2021 at 12:01 a.m. The Court of Common Pleas, General Division, will resume normal operations at that time.

The Court continues to encourage employees and anyone entering the Justice Center to be respectful of the personal space of others and to exercise proper hygiene and sanitization. The Court will continue to have hand sanitizer available throughout the Justice Center. The Court will permit anyone who desires to wear a facial cover in the Justice Center to do so.





Each Judge retains the discretion to impose specific requirements to be followed in their Courtroom. Any such requirement shall be posted on the Court's website, and shall be available at the security checkpoint.
